Day Services

The Bridge provides a safe and non-judgemental service to the homeless and vulnerably housed in Leicester. The Bridge offers support to anyone who is homeless or who is at risk of becoming homeless, this includes rough sleepers, people who are sofa-surfing and those who are in temporary or unsuitable accommodation. Breakfast and lunch are served daily. Hot food and drinks and a warm and friendly place to meet and chat. Provision of clothes, toiletries, food parcels, use of washing, changing, shower facilities etc for rough sleepers.

Open 9.30am-4:30pm: Thursday 21st, Friday 22nd, Monday 25th, Thursday 28th, Friday 29th, Saturday 30th (9am - 1pm), Tuesday 2nd.

Closed: Wednesdays and Sundays (apart from Christmas Day, Sunday 25th December) and closed Tuesday 26th December and Monday 1st January. Return to normal opening from Tuesday 2nd January.

No5 is a Day Centre providing support for those who are experiencing substance misuse issues and who are also experiencing homelessness. No5 provides support with management of substance misuse via advice and referral.

For those who are rough sleeping it provides breakfast, shower facilities and clothes washing. No5 also provides a venue for other agencies to provide services, these include Social Worker, Turning Point, Hepatitis C testing and Homeless Mental Health.

Opening hours are 08.00 – 15.30 Monday to Thursday and 08.00 – 15.00 Fridays. No.5 will close early, at 2pm on Friday 22nd December 2023.
